Overview

Vocabulary, Creative Writing, Language and Communication Development

This activity is an exercise in creative writing. Using the first ten words correctly answered on Freerice to write a one page story to read out loud in your class

Aims & Objectives

- To develop vocabulary skills
- To exercise creative writing skills
- To develop language and communication skills

Instructions

1. Have students play the Vocabulary Subject on Freerice. <http://freerice.com/>
2. Let students make a list of the first ten vocabulary words they correctly answer.
Note: The Vocabulary section automatically starts at a basic level. If the students are logged in Freerice will remember the last level they were at and may begin at a more advanced level.
3. Instruct students to use the words in a one-page story.
Adaptation: Instead of a story, students can be instructed to write a poem using the words.
4. Allow students to read their stories outloud to the class.
